

Career Boost E&T Support Services: FFY 2021

Support Services for engaged Career Boost participant may be submitted for 50/50 match. To qualify for 50/50 match, support services must be:

- Listed as a contracted service in a Contractor’s SOW.
- Entered as a cost in the customer’s iMatchSkills record.
- Be on the list below and in accordance with customer’s SNAP E&T case plan

In approving support service payments, providers must consider lower-cost alternatives. It is the program’s expectation providers and participants work collaboratively to seek resources that are reasonably available to the participant in order to engage in activities.

Books	Participants may receive assistance with textbooks, training materials, and other reasonable and necessary school supplies for training.
Clothing	Clothing for interviewing or for employment purposes may be provided.
Course Registration Fees	Participants may receive assistance with lab fees and other education related costs necessary for training connected to a SNAP E&T activity.
Child Care Expenses	If the provider has elected to provide this support service for those participating in an approved SNAP E&T activity.
Driver’s License Testing fee and standard license fee	Enhance license, only if it is required for an offered job position. May not include paying penalty fees or debts.
Fingerprinting	Only if required for a job.
Housing	Limited to two months and costs must be reasonable. Participant must have exhausted all other potential resources and show a plan to be able to pay for housing costs going forward.
Permits and Fees	Union dues, test fees, licensing and bonding fees, background checks
Personal Identification	State ID, birth certificates, driver’s license, etc.

Transportation Expenses (public transportation fare and gasoline)	Transportation assistance may include: - Transit tickets or passes - Gas cards
Work and Training Tools (equipment, tools safety clothing, uniforms)	Determine the need for those tools on a case-by-case basis.
